It has been agreed on what follows:

Having been made aware of, and considering, the educational recommendations presented by the European Association of Real Estate Professions (CEPI) and acknowledging that these recommendations could be a reliable basis for a common minimum syllabus for Property Agents and/or Managers in the EU Member States,

the foresaid establishment

- 1.- will aim to apply these recommendations within the framework of the various courses given for Property Agents and/or Managers, in conformity with the national legislation and regulations in force.
- 2.- commits itself to send the list of the given courses to CEPI and to inform the latter of every updating or change.
- 3.- acknowledges that these recommendations are minimum criteria.
- 4.- has agreed to the conditions in appendix.

In consideration of this commitment, the European Association of Real Estate Professions (CEPI) will consider the **granting of a *CEPI Eur label*** to the abovementioned Establishment, on the conditions in appendix.

Appendix

- 1.- **CEPI Eur label** is a document granted to the establishment and not to the student.
- 2.- **CEPI Eur label** will be granted following the written recommendation of the CEPI national member association(s) operating in the relevant country.
- 3.- **CEPI Eur label** does not confer compliance with national or transnational legislative requirements.
- 4.- **CEPI certificate** given by establishments with the **CEPI Eur label** does not entitle graduates to practice automatically as a property agent or manager either in the country where the label is granted or in the other EU Member States.
- 5.- **CEPI certificate** does not give the right to automatic membership to any CEPI Association, as some associations have standards/requirements above CEPI's minimum level and may also have other criteria for membership.
- 6.- CEPI will provide a central register of recognised courses for the benefit of colleges to facilitate exchange of ideas and of student exchange and for the benefit of students deciding on a suitable college.
- 7.- At a CEPI member association's request, the **CEPI Eur label** may be withdrawn at one year's notice, subject to considering first a response from the college.
- 8.- Any significant change by a college to its course for property agents and/or managers should be approved by CEPI for "continuing recognition".
