The PUEB Partner Club -

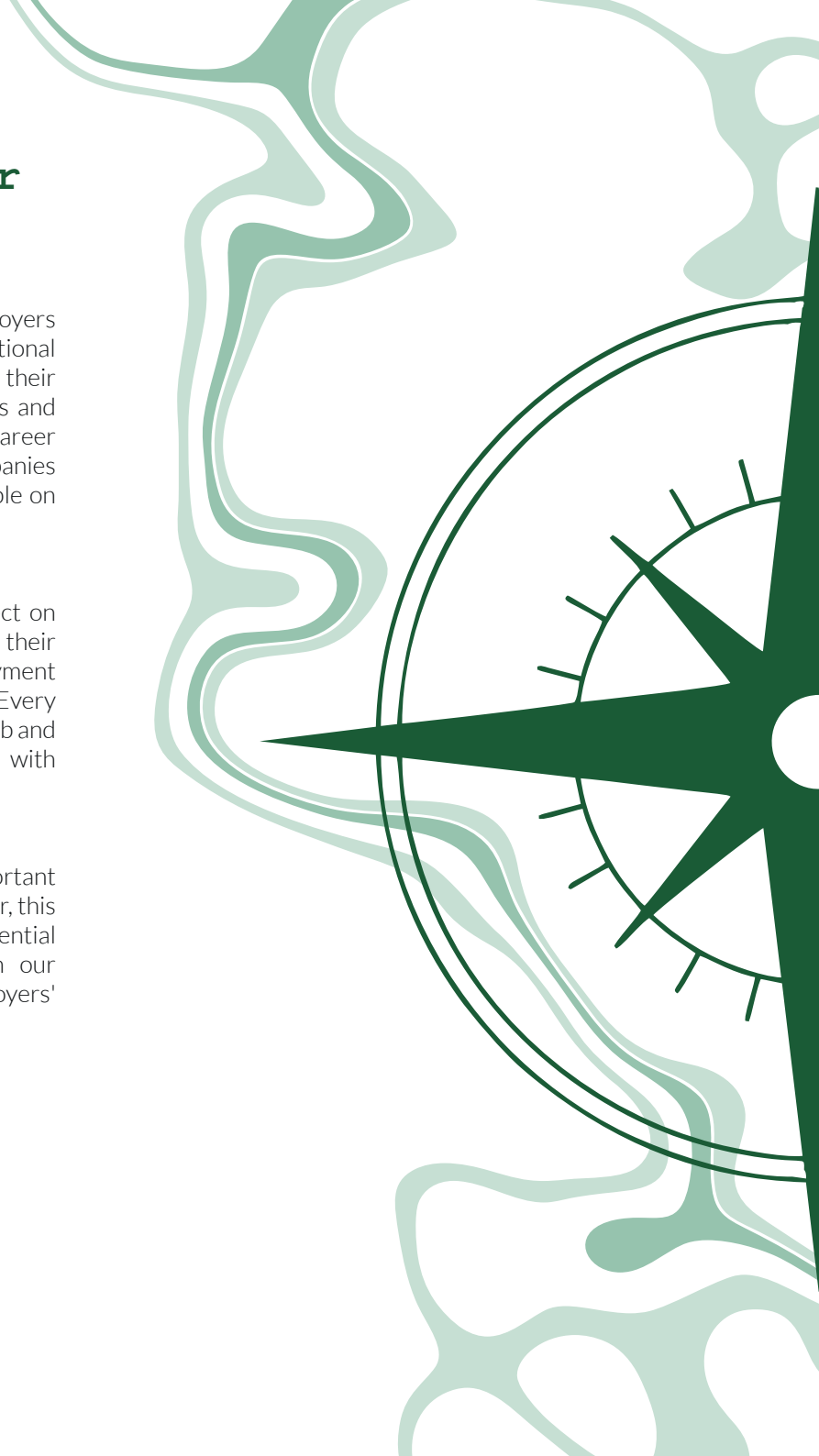

Programmes in economics

Economics

Do you dream of a degree programme that will help you understand economic phenomena and learn to predict their consequences, so that you can develop effective competitive strategies for a company and come up with solutions that ensure its market success? Are you interested in managing people, or working in PR agencies and the media? We have the right programme for you! During your studies in economics, you will gain in-depth knowledge, practical skills and a wide scope of social competencies. The high qualifications of economics graduates have been valued by employers for years. Graduates have a wide range of employment opportunities.

Key features:

- a degree enabling a professional career across a wide range of professions and job roles,
- the programme offers five diverse specialisation programmes.

Career prospects:

managers, economic analysts, economic advisers, specialists in economic departments, specialists in EU funding, market analysis and human resources in private companies, local and central government bodies, EU institutions, and business owners.

Legal and economic studies

Economics of Social Well-being

Social Welfare Economics is a degree programme for those who wish to develop an understanding of how to improve the quality of life within society, organisations and business. If you are interested in economics, data analysis and modern approaches to human behaviour and the way organisations operate, this is the place for you.

During your studies, you will acquire economic, social and managerial knowledge, as well as soft skills, language skills, and analytical and research skills, whilst developing strong practical competencies: problem diagnosis, change design, securing funding (including EU funds), project management, evaluation, accountability, and reporting results. You will learn to apply knowledge of social behaviour, create data-driven innovations, and work effectively in a team.

The programme is distinguished by:

- Interdisciplinarity – sound, broad knowledge of economics, social science, management and analytics;
- A practical approach – workshops, exercises, projects, study visits and tutoring, through which students learn by doing;
- Preparation for real-world social challenges – you analyse current problems and create solutions that meet the needs of people and organisations;
- Development of future-oriented skills – project work, presentations, advocacy, negotiations, cross-sectoral communication;
- Opportunities to engage in additional experiences – work placements, volunteering and business relations with public institutions, social organisations and other organisations.

Career prospects:

work in corporate finance and accounting departments, in audit firms, in specialist accounting firms, running one's own accounting practice, chief accountants, financial directors and financial advisers, and, upon fulfilment of additional statutory requirements, chartered auditors and tax advisers.

Get hands-on experience in using management tools, methods and techniques, as well as analysing and diagnosing processes within an organisation and its environment. We offer a programme that focuses on the practical application of theory in business and meets labour-market needs by training professionals – specialists with high-level skills who are creative and open to collaboration.

Key features:

- The programme develops the essential skills needed to take up professional roles in specialist and managerial positions, as consultants in businesses, non-profit organisations, or local and central government, and to run your own business.

Career prospects:

business owners and entrepreneurs, HR business partners, managers overseeing a specific area of a company, project managers, project developers, marketing specialists in manufacturing, retail and service companies, media analysts, property valuers, specialists in fixed asset and investment management.

The ranking points for qualifying subjects are calculated based on the percentage score achieved in the written part of the examination.

The ranking points for applicants who sat the school-leaving examination in a chosen subject at the extended (advanced) level are calculated as follows:
(percentage score at the extended level + 100): 2.

The number of ranking points for applicants who sat the school-leaving examination in a selected subject at the basic level is calculated as follows:
(percentage score at the basic level + 40): 2.

The number of ranking points for applicants who sat the school-leaving examination in a foreign language according to the standards applicable to bilingual classes is calculated as follows: **(1.4 × percentage score at the bilingual class level + 100): 2**, provided that the total number of points may not exceed the maximum number of points available for the foreign language.

If an applicant has obtained fewer than 30 percentage points at the selected examination level (this applies to the school-leaving examination and secondary schools completed abroad, where examination results are expressed as a percentage) in a qualifying subject, it is assumed that they have obtained 0 points in that subject.

The maximum number of points that can be obtained in a subject or foreign language is 100.



Applicants sitting selected vocational examinations or examinations confirming vocational qualifications may submit their vocational examination result instead of the result from an additional matriculation subject.

Applicants holding an International Baccalaureate diploma or a school-leaving certificate obtained abroad have their ranking points calculated based on the results of the qualifying subjects for the PUEB listed on those documents.

International applicants are admitted under separate rules:



The admissions procedure for English-language degree programmes is competition-based. It takes into account the scores obtained in the subjects required for admission to the PUEB, as recorded on the document serving as the basis for admission (the Polish secondary school leaving certificate or its foreign equivalent).

1.

Complete the online application form.

2.

Pay the application fee by the deadline.

3.

Check your ranking points to see if you have progressed to the next stage.

4.

If your score is equal to or higher than the cut-off mark, submit your documents; if it is lower, wait for the cut-off mark to be lowered, if applicable.

5.

Once your submitted documents have been successfully verified, you will receive notification of your admission (on the day the results are announced).

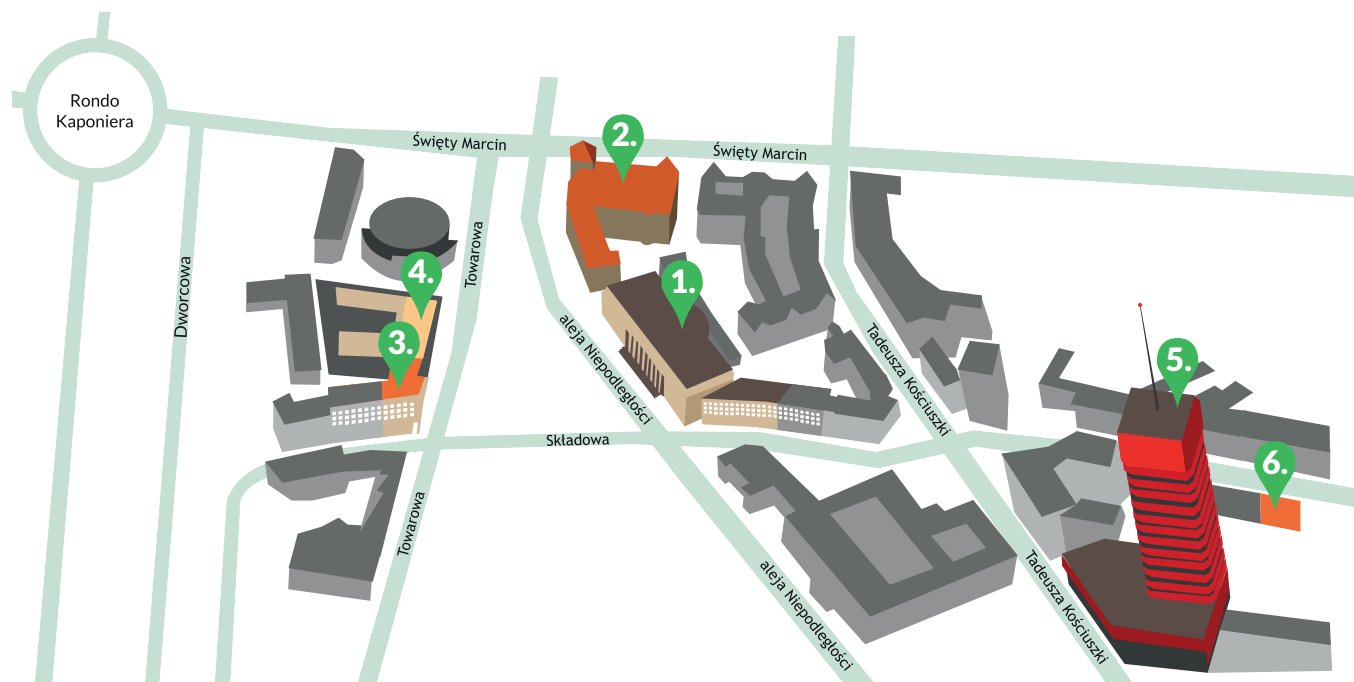

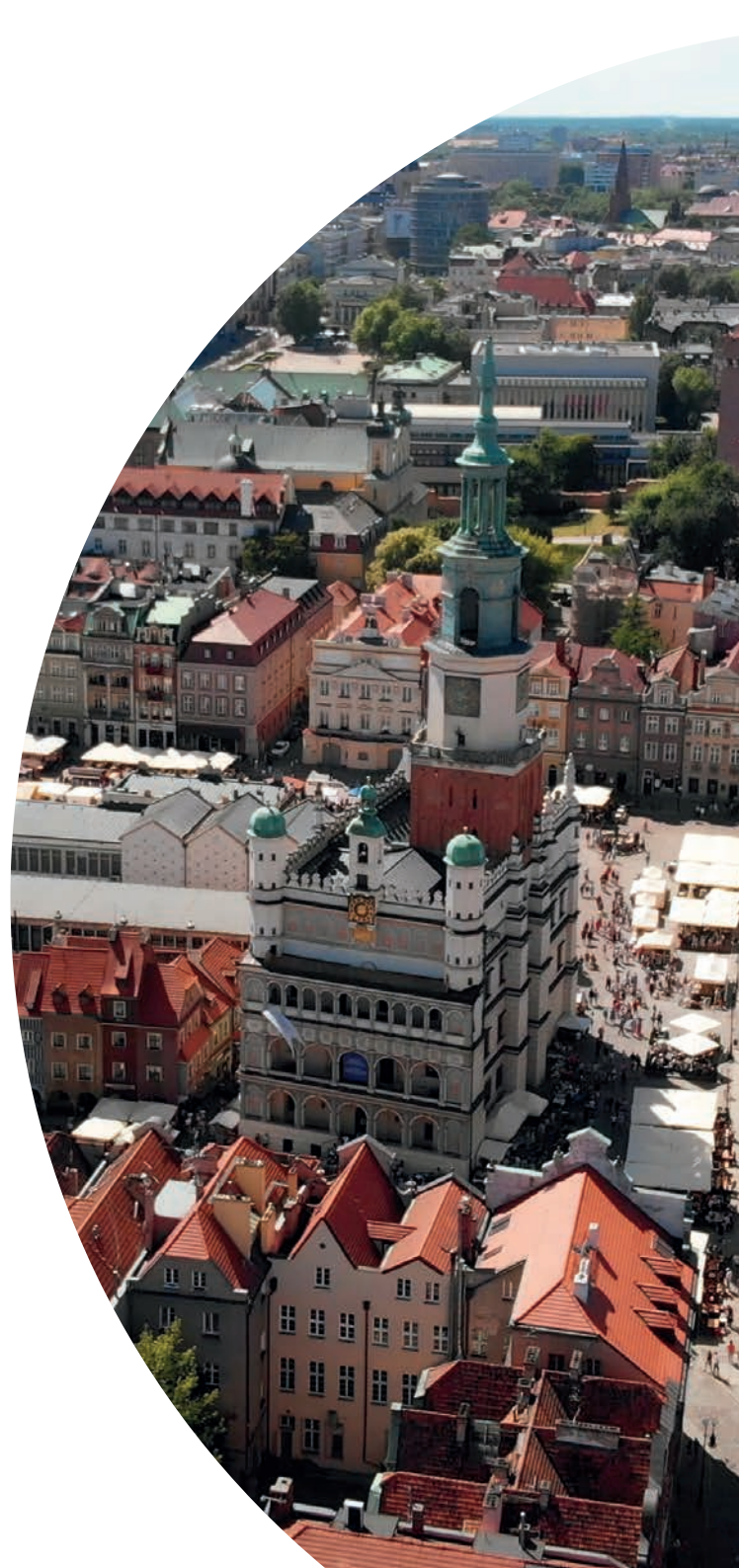
