

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Formatting (MS Word, docx format)

- A4 size paper, margin – 25 mm on all sides
- 12 pt and 1.5 line spacing for body text, 10 pt and single line spacing for notes
- Times New Roman
- layout of metadata and content, title and headings format – according to the attached template
- tables and figures should be provided in an editable version
