We cordially invite you to participate in the webinar in English devoted to the latest projections of world population development, which will take place on July 12 at 3:00 PM on the Zoom platform.

Since 1989, World Population Day has been celebrated on July 11. It was established by the UN General Assembly on the initiative of the Governing Council of the United Nations Development Program (UNDP). The inspiration for its creation was public interest in the Five Billion Day, which took place on July 11, 1987, the approximate date on which the world's population reached five billion people.

World Population Day aims to draw attention to issues related to the development of the world's population, including family planning, gender equality, poverty, maternal health, and human rights. On this day, the UN Population Division also announces its biennial population projections. This year's projections mark the 28th edition published by the UN Population Division.
