







Korean National Health Insurance

Mandatory nation-wide insurance for all international students including exchange students staying in Korea for more than 3 months. Required to purchase even with a similar insurance coverage from a student's home country. Keep in mind that those who completed the alien registration will be eligible for the services.

- Cost: 70 USD/month
- Coverages : various including the following benefits
 - Dental treatment
 - Oriental medical treatment
 - Pregnancy and childbirth-related medical expenses
 - Outpatient medical service: 30-60%, varies by medical care institution type and area
 - Hospitalization expenses: 20%
 - Beneficiareis pay part of the medical expenses.
 - The insured is not required to claim benefits after receiving treatment.
 - Number and amount of benefits are not limited
- Non-coverage: treatment for diseases that do not affect work or daily life

Scholarships

International exchange students are eligible for the following scholarships.

Merit Scholarship

- Eligibility: CNU exchange student with a CGPA of at least 80 out of 100
- Number of Recipients: 5 students per semester
- Benefits : Dormitory and meal plan fee waiver
- Application Procedure
 - 1. No application is needed (automatic selection).
 - 2. If selected for the scholarship, the recipient(s) will be notified via email.

Best Partner Scholarship

CNU checks the balance of the exchange students at the end of every year. If CNU sent 2 more students than the partner university in the preceding year, CNU will award a scholarship to the exchanges students from the partner university.

- Eligibility: Exchange students from the partner university
- Number of Recipients: up to 3 students from the partner university
- Benefits: 500,000 KRW, one semester only
- Application Procedure
 - 1. No application is needed (automatic selection).
 - 2. If selected for the scholarship, the recipient(s) will be notified via email.

Global Korea Scholarship

- Eligibility: Incoming CNU exchange student with at least CGPA 80 out of 100
- Number of Students : 5~10 students per semester
- Benefits
 - Round-trip Flight Ticket Fees
 - Monthly Allowance: 630,000 KRW per month(4 month)
- Application Procedure
 - 1. No application is needed (automatic selection).
 - 2. The list of selected students will be sent to the Ministry of Education (NIIED).

Gwangju Immigration Office

Korean Bank Account
