Men and women differ in their ability to achieve various outcomes, both in the labor market and within the household. Disparities in the likelihood of success persist despite decades of efforts to eliminate them. Understanding these gaps requires looking not only at labor market outcomes, but also at how families are formed and how roles are allocated within households, how stereotypes are transmitted, and how social perceptions of ability shape educational and occupational choices from an early age. The GGaps 2026 Conference will explore these persistent inequalities.

We invite papers on gender inequality from the fields of economics, management, sociology, and social psychology. Research examining the intersection of professional aspirations, household roles, and bargaining power is especially welcome. The conference welcomes empirical quantitative research, experimental studies, as well as qualitative work. Priority will be given to empirical and experimental papers with strong theoretical foundations; however, studies advancing econometric and statistical methods for measuring gender inequality, as well as well-developed case studies, are also encouraged.
