



Call for Proposals

for chapters in the scientific monograph

**“The societal impact of artificial intelligence:
insights from empirical studies
from young researchers”**

Since the introduction of large language models in 2022, the role that artificial intelligence plays in society has rapidly increased. To better understand this influence, we are hereby inviting young researchers to submit proposals for their research, that will be published by the Poznań University of Economics and Business Press in a scientific monograph titled “The societal impact of artificial intelligence: insights from empirical studies from young researchers”.

Research we are eliciting

We are eliciting empirical work that focuses on any topic that involves artificial intelligence – including generative AI (large language models) – but are entirely open on how this data was collected (e.g., by prompting various large language models, using surveys, using experiments).

Authorship

The monograph is intended to serve as a medium for young researchers to make their first steps in science. We define young researchers as undergraduate students and graduate students in all years of their studies.

It is preferable that the papers are authored solely by young researchers (e.g., members of scientific research circles), but it is possible for their thesis supervisors to be co-authors in the paper, although not the first one.

Publication process

The publication process will consist of the following phases:

1. Submission of proposals. Deadline: **31st May 2026**
2. Feedback on proposals (preliminary acceptance) – **7th June 2026**
3. Submission of papers (3,000-4,000 words). Deadline: **30th September 2026**
4. Feedback on papers (reviews) – **30th November 2026**
5. Submission of corrected version of papers. Deadline: **31st December 2026**
6. Copyediting and publication of monograph: **first quarter of 2027**

Requirements for proposals

The proposals should be no longer than 500 words and describe the purpose of the proposed study and the proposed methodology of the study.
