The personal data contained in the application form shall be stored for the period of five years starting from 1 January, following the year of completing studies, subject to the condition that upon the expiry of this period, they shall be archived which shall be conducted by the state archives.
- 8. The data shall be processed by employees of the Poznań University of Economics and Business or by persons employed by the Poznań University of Economics and Business on the basis of civil law contracts pursuant to the granted by the Controller authorizations to process personal data.

- 9. The data subject is entitled to demand from the Controller of data access to their personal data, amending them, removing or limiting their processing within the limits allowed by the law.
 - Data subject is also entitled to submit an objection against the processing of personal data, withdraw their consent for data processing at any time without it impacting compliance with the law of the processing performed on the basis of consent prior to such a withdrawal. The applying person is entitled to obtain, within a standardised, machine-readable form, personal data concerning them which were delivered to the Controller and such personal data may be transferred to another administrator without obstacles on the side of the Controller.
