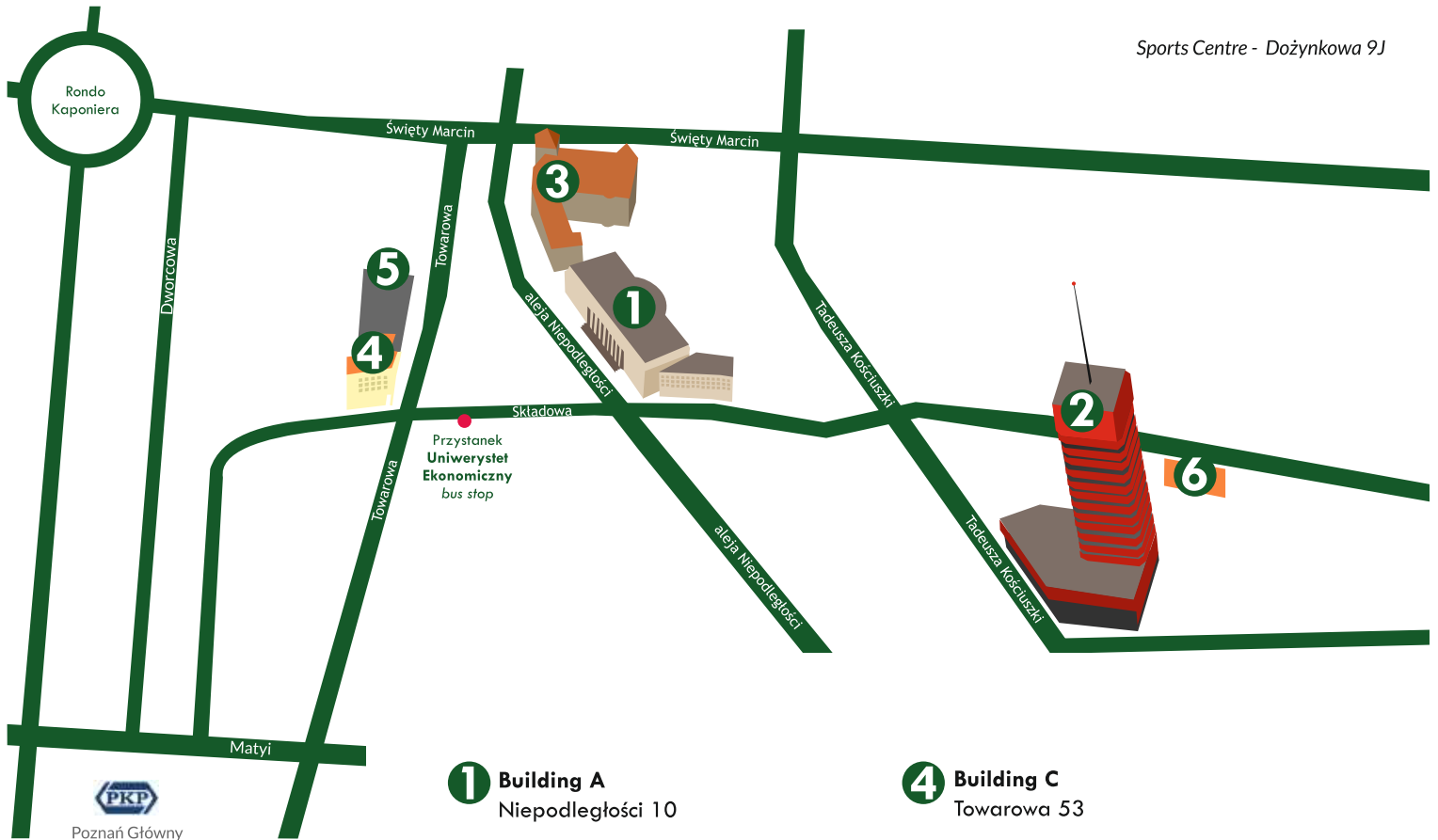

The program's mission is to develop and disseminate leading-edge knowledge concerning the theory and practice of economics and business in the globalized world. A multitude of political, social and cultural forces drive economic and business

decisions in world. To understand these forces, students need to learn about and to understand the many challenges faced by today's companies, individuals and economies. Product and process management course is prepared in accordance with the European Principles for the Enhancement of Learning and Teaching, current OECD Skills Outlook and employee skills review by Economist Intelligence Unit. The program encompasses knowledge and practical aspects of natural, technical, economic and other social sciences.

The combination of managerial skills with technical knowledge and competences makes the graduate able to:

- acquire, analyse and critically evaluate information obtained from various scientific and professional sources, design new and develop existing processes and products (both material goods and services),
- analyse the life cycle of products, processes and organisations, including their impact on the environment,
- introduce and maintain a project management and/or cost management,
- manage staff and coordinate the work of teams,
- plan research and development work on selected products and processes in enterprises.

Recruitment process in 7 steps

The process of application is standardized and easy to perform.

Step 1
Choose your field of study and specialization

3

Step 3
Prepare color scans of your documents to be uploaded in a system:

- Passport
- High school diploma and Bachelor diploma (if you are applying for Master programme)
- Certificate of English language skills
- motivation letter

Check in the Polish embassy the process of getting a visa and legalization of your documents.

Step 2
Fill in the application form at apply.ue.poznan.pl

4

Step 4
After positive verification of your documents will receive an email with an invitation to a short Skype interview to talk about your interests.

5

Step 5
You will be given the account number for the first semester fee. When we confirm the transfer we will issue the admission letter which will be used to apply for a visa.

7

Step 7
Come to Poland at least two weeks before the semester starts. Visit the office and bring all the original documents.

6

Step 6
Apply for a visa in a Polish consulate. Remember to take all your documents to be legalized by a Polish consul.



CEEMAN IQA

International Quality Accreditation is awarded to universities by the International Association for Management Development in Dynamic Societies based in Bled (Slovenia). CEEMAN is involved in supporting the development of management and innovation, and improving the quality of education in business schools and institutions associated with the development of management science.

The last time AMBA accreditation was granted in 2019 for the period of 5 years.
