

POSTER GUIDELINES

1. A scientific poster should be characterized by a concise presentation of information (description of the research conducted and the results obtained), in a simple, accessible and understandable form (both text and graphic).
2. Posters should be prepared and printed on your own.
3. Posters should be placed, on special exhibition boards. The necessary equipment for attaching posters will be provided by the organizing committee
4. Posters should be removed from the boards after the poster session.
5. Poster dimensions: **max. B1 format – 70 cm (width) x 100 cm (height) - vertical orientation**
6. **The layout of poster content should include:**
 - a. Title (author/s, institution),
 - b. Introduction, Objective,
 - c. Methods,
 - d. Results,
 - e. Conclusions,
 - f. Literature (optional).
7. All tables and graphics should be provided with descriptions and/or titles. The titles should be placed above the tables. Captions should be placed under diagrams, charts, photographs, and other graphics.
8. The following **font sizes** are suggested:
 - a. for the main text - not less than 26 points,
 - b. for descriptions - not less than 18 points,
 - c. for headings - bold and correspondingly larger than for the main text.

Please note that three awards will be given for the best posters during the conference.
