Course Summary and Objectives

<Course Summary>

Management accounting is the process of measuring, analyzing, and reporting financial and non-financial information that helps managers make decisions to fulfill the goals of an organization. This course aims to provide students with knowledge of how managers can use management accounting information to support planning, controlling, and decision-making. Each week, students must give a presentation on their assigned chapter in the textbook and discuss the instructor's questions.

<Objectives>

The objective of the course is to provide students with knowledge of the following management accounting techniques:

- 1)Inventory costing
- 2)Master budget and responsibility accounting
